

Membership

All UEA students and staff are entitled to become members of the Library. Before registering you will need to complete a V7 form (available from UEA Library or Sir Thomas Browne Library) which must be approved by UEA Library Services.

To register you will need to come to the Library with your campus card and complete a registration card. Membership will be for the length of your course or contract.

Borrowing Books

You can borrow up to 5 books 24 hours a day from our self-service kiosk. You will need your Campus card and PIN to do this.

We will send email reminders for any books which are due for return or overdue. Fines are charged for overdue books.

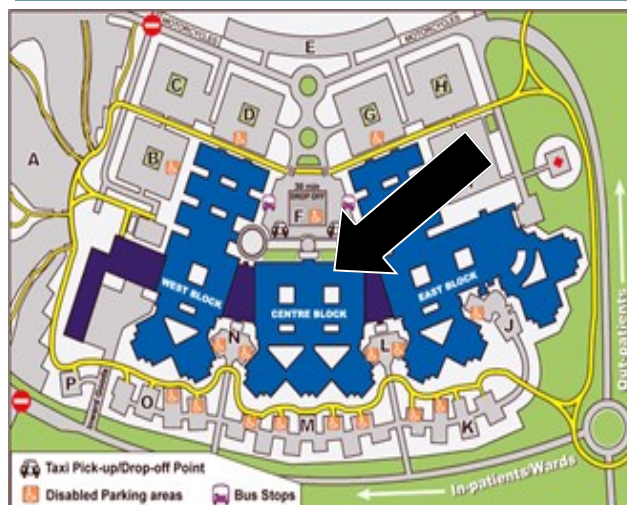

Library Catalogue

Choose NN from the dropdown list to search for books in Sir Thomas Browne Library. To renew items you will need your user ID and PIN. Your user ID is your campus card number preceded by NN. (eg. NN2807)

You can renew your books twice online as long as they have not been reserved by another user.

Binding

OpenAthens

Nursing, medical and allied health professional students are entitled to an NHS OpenAthens account which provides access to a range of electronic resources. Your OpenAthens account will be managed by the UEA Health Librarian, please contact the UEA Library for more information.

Books are arranged in the Library using the National Library of Medicine classification scheme. Journals are arranged alphabetically by title. Only issues from the last year are held in the library. Articles from older issues can be copied from our off-site store at request, for a small fee, please allow 24 hours notice.
