How do I Join?

Visit the Sir Thomas Browne Library and speak to a Librarian who will discuss your requirements, to ensure that the most relevant information is sent straight to your inbox.

Once logged in you can request a search for evidence, view previous search requests, book onto forthcoming teaching, download certificates of attendance, and update your professional interests so we can keep you informed.



What is KnowledgeShare ?

Are you overwhelmed by too much information?

KnowledgeShare allows **members** to sign up for news and evidence updates highlighting newly published health care information.

These updates are targeted specifically to your area of professional interest, so cutting out the irrelevant stuff.

Who is eligible to use KnowledgeShare?

All NNUH staff are eligible to use KnowledgeShare provided they are members of the Sir Thomas Browne Library.

KnowledgeShare Members Can...

- Request Evidence Searches
- Find searches requested by colleagues (where permission granted)
- Sign up for highly targeted updates based on their professional interests
- Book onto library skills training sessions and manage their bookings
- Connect with colleagues based on shared professional interests

How do I access KnowledgeShare?

Members can access KnowledgeShare using their NHS OpenAthens password. All NHS staff are eligible for an NHS OpenAthens password and can register for free at <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/>

What are targeted evidence updates ?

As well as providing access to evidence search services and information skills teaching, KnowledgeShare provides targeted evidence updates to your email address.

These updates are **individualised** based on your interest in particular **conditions** or **lifestyle factors, age groups, settings of care, interventions** and **management** topics.

KnowledgeShare informs you about **new evidence** that matters, focusing on high-level evidence, publications on management and educational topics, and local professional development events. You will be kept up-to-date without being overwhelmed with information.
